COMMANDERIE DU BONTEMPS CELEBRATES 70 YEARS OF FRENCH EXCELLENCE

In 2020, Commanderie du Bontemps, Médoc, Graves, Sauternes and Barsac, one of the oldest and largest winegrowing brotherhoods, celebrates 70 years of promoting the great wines of the Bordeaux's left bank.

For 70 years, the Commanderie has striven to highlight its marvellous historic estates, and to build the worldwide reputation of their wines, which are a central theme in the story of Bordeaux and French culture.

The 70th anniversary celebrations will begin on 10th February 2020 with an exclusive gala dinner in the Gallery of Great Battles in the Palace of Versailles. This event will host 650 international guests and will be an amazing opportunity to spotlight French culture, heritage and expertise.

It will also pay tribute to the Commanderie's founders, who organised their very first dinner under the Eiffel Tower in 1950. At the same time, they were received at the Elysée Palace to induct their first Commandeur of Honour, the then state French President Vincent Auriol.

Since then, more than 40,000 celebrities have been honoured all over the world, including politicians, artists and even crowned heads. Year after year, the brotherhood perpetuates its values of generosity, friendship and openness on the world.

The Commanderie induction ceremony contains the assertion "Everywhere and before anyone", declaring how it represents, celebrates and defends not only wine, but all the values that are closely related as well: **friendship, fine living and loyalty to the terroir.**
